

PCIM Europe Student Travel Grants

PCIM Europe offers a small number of supplemental travel grants (EUR 500 each) to support international students to attend **PCIM Europe 2022**. The travel grants will be provided to eligible and selected student authors who will present an accepted paper at **PCIM Europe Conference 2022**.

What does this grant cover?

Each grant is intended to partially reimburse travel expenses (airfare, ground transportation, and/or hotel). Meals and the conference registration fee are not eligible for reimbursement.

Who can apply?

To qualify for the travel grant, applicants must be a full-time student at an international university (excluding Germany, Austria and Switzerland) registered toward a Bachelor/ Masters/ PhD degree related to power electronics. A student who is awarded a travel grant must register, attend the conference in person and present the paper (oral or poster) at **PCIM Europe Conference 2022**.

How to apply?

An application for the Student Travel Grant must consist of:

- The student's resume, including your citizenship
- Information about the availability of funds from other sources

Important deadlines

To be considered for the student travel grant, applicants must **submit their abstract online by 15 October 2021** and send the above mentioned information as PDF to Christina.Haldy@mesago.com. Grant applicants will be notified in **January 2022**.

How are grant recipients reimbursed?

Grant recipients must collect and submit their travel receipts. Payment will only be made to the student as long as the recipient submits the expense report (with original receipts) within 30 days after the conference. Reimbursements will not exceed the total amount of EUR 500 each.
